

## **Bobby Rodrigo - We Do Better Relief**

A retired logistics expert from the US Navy Bobby has been working inside of disaster relief since responding to Hurricane Andrew in 1993. His work has included rebuilding the Naval housing in Key West post Hurricanes Wilma and Katrina. Handling dispatch and manpower allocation for Hurricane Sandy.

Logistical lead for all phases of moving 122 40' Containers of commodities and 58 plane loads, shipped and flown to Puerto Rico, USVI, Saint Marteen, Dominica, Bahamas and Haiti impacting over 1 million residents of the Caribbean. Valued at 15 million dollars' worth of commodities and equipment.

Installed Micro Farms at evacuee centers in Houston and Puerto Rico to assist in food supplies.

Created and executed hot meal plans in Houston and Puerto Rico serving over 50,000 meals. Allocated manpower, equipment, food, water and medical supplies in Texas, Florida, Dominica and Puerto Rico.

Handled all phases of delivery of 3.5 million servings of vegetables and seafood to the Caribbean

Managed over 350 volunteers and employed during Harvey, Irma, and Maria

Establish emergency relief logistics and information for every municipality in Puerto. Executed the plan within 60 days.
